

NOTICE INVITING BIDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the VICTOR VALLEY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT of San Bernardino County, California, acting by and through its Governing Board, hereinafter referred to as DISTRICT, will receive up to, but not later than **10:00 AM on Tuesday, the 28th day of March 2006**, sealed bids for the **REBID OF BID PACKAGES 15 AND 18** for the following project:

ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY BUILDING

Per California Civil Code 3247 the successful bidder with a bid in excess of \$25,000.00 will be required to furnish the District with a Performance Bond equal to 100% of the successful bid, and a Payment Bond equal to 100% of the successful bid, prior to execution of the contract. All bonds are to be secured from a surety company that meets all of the State of California bonding requirements, as defined in Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120, and is authorized by the State of California. All prime contractors bidding on this project must specify this requirement regarding subcontractor bonds, in their written or published request for subcontractor bids. Such written or published requests must clearly designate the party that will bear the cost of the bonds. Vendors only supplying materials shall not be required to provide bonds. All subcontractor bonds are to be secured from a surety company that meets all of the State of California bonding requirements, as defined in Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120, and is authorized by the State of California.

Pursuant to the provisions of Public Contract Code Section 22300, Contractor may substitute certain securities for funds withheld by District to ensure his performance under the contract. At the request and expense of Contractor, securities equivalent to any amount withheld shall be deposited at the discretion of District, with either District or a state or federally chartered bank, as the escrow agent, who shall then pay any funds otherwise subject to retention to Contractor. Upon satisfactory completion of the contract, the securities shall be returned to Contractor.

Each bidder shall be a licensed contractor pursuant to the Business and Professions Code and shall be licensed in the appropriate classification(s) of contractor's license(s), for the work bid upon, and must maintain the license throughout the duration of the Contract.

All bids shall be made and presented on forms furnished by the District. Bids shall be received at the District Facilities Construction & Contracts, 18422 Bear Valley Road, Victorville, California 92395, (760) 245-4271 ext. 2250 at or before the time and date stated above, at which time they shall be opened and publicly read aloud.

Each bid must conform with and be responsive to all pertinent bidding and contract documents. Beginning Wednesday, March 8, 2006 prospective bidders may secure a set of said documents through Cal K-12 Construction, Inc., (909) 795-9169, Fax (909) 795-9432; www.calk12.com. There is a \$200.00 refundable deposit for plans and Specifications. Contractors may get up to four (4) sets. Please call to assure availability.

A site job-walk will not be conducted. Contact Cal K-12 Construction, Inc. with any questions.

The District has obtained from the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work in the locality in which the work is to be performed for each craft, classification, and/or type of work needed to execute the contract. Copies of schedules of rates so determined are on file at the District Facilities Construction & Contracts. The Contractor shall post a copy of the determination of prevailing rate of wages at the job site. The schedule of per diem wages

is based upon a working day of eight (8) hours and the rate for holiday and overtime work shall be in accordance with the applicable provisions of the California Labor Code. The Contractor and any subcontractor(s) shall pay not less than the specified prevailing rates of wages to all workers employed by them in the execution of the contract.

The District reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to waive irregularities in any bid.
