NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the VICTOR VALLEY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT of San Bernardino County, California, acting by and through its Governing Board, hereinafter referred to as DISTRICT, **HAS EXTENDED THE BID DEADLINE** and will receive bids up to, but not later than **10:00 am local time on May 8, 2008**, sealed bids for the following project:

**SEISMIC REPLACEMENT GYMNASIUM

All bids shall be made and presented on forms furnished by the District. Bids shall be received at the District Facilities Construction & Contracts Office, 18422 Bear Valley Road, Victorville, California 92395, (760) 245-4271 ext. 2250 at or before the time and date stated above, at which time they shall be opened and publicly read aloud.

Each bid must conform with and be responsive to all pertinent bidding and contract documents, copies of which are on file and may be obtained from the District Facilities Construction & Contracts Office. Prospective bidders may secure a set of said documents through Cal K-12 Construction, Inc., 32598 Oak Glen Road, Yucaipa, CA 92399 (909) 795-9169, Fax (909) 795-9432; www.calk12.com. There is a \$300.00 refundable deposit for plans and specifications. Contractors may get up to four (4) sets. Plans must be returned in good shape within 10 working days of bid.

A non-mandatory site job-walk will be conducted Wednesday, April 23, 2008, at Victor Valley Community College, 18422 Bear Valley Road, Victorville, commencing at 9:00 AM. All Parties to meet at the north end of Parking Lot 20 at Fish Hatchery Road Entrance. Parking Lot 20 is located between the two existing gymnasiums on campus. Representatives of the District, the Construction Manager, and the Architect will be present to address any questions bidders may have regarding this Project. Call Cal K-12 at (909) 795-9169 for additional information or directions.

The District has obtained from the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work in the locality in which the work is to be performed for each craft, classification, and/or type of work needed to execute the contract. Copies of schedules of rates so determined are on file at the District Facilities Construction & Contracts Office. The Contractor shall post a copy of the determination of prevailing rate of wages at the job site. The schedule of per diem wages is based upon a working day of eight (8) hours and the rate for holiday and overtime work shall be in accordance with the applicable provisions of the California Labor Code. The Contractor and any subcontractor(s) shall pay not less than the specified prevailing rates of wages to all workers employed by them in the execution of the contract.

A payment bond and performance bond will be required prior to the execution of the contract. The payment bond and performance bond shall be in the form and amount set forth in the contract documents.

In accordance with provisions of Public Contract Code §22300, substitution of eligible and equivalent securities for any monies withheld to ensure performance under this contract will be permitted at the request and expense of the Contractor.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date set for the opening of bids.

The District reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to waive irregularities in any bid.
