Notice is hereby given that the San Bernardino County Superintendent of Schools, hereinafter called District, will receive sealed bids up to, but not later than the time fixed above, for the award of contracts for the:

SBCSS Special Day Classroom at Jr/Sr High School No. 2

CATEGORY 1: General Construction

CATEGORY 6: Roofing and Sheet Metal

CATEGORY 2: Plumbing

CATEGORY 7: Plaster and Gypsum Board Systems

CATEGORY 3: HVAC

CATEGORY 8: Fire Sprinklers

CATEGORY 4: Electrical

CATEGORY 5: Casework

Bids will be awarded on the basis of the base package price.

All bids shall be made on the bid form furnished by the District.

Sealed bids will be received at the District, Purchasing Office, 4595 Hallmark Parkway, San Bernardino, California, 92407, on or before the time and date stated above at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids will remain sealed until the time and date stated.

Each bid must conform and be responsive to all pertinent Bidding and Contract Documents. Copies are on file and open for public inspection at the District Office.

Prospective prime contract bidders may secure up to four (4) sets of construction documents from the Office of the District's Construction Manager, Cal K-12 Construction, Inc. upon payment of a refundable deposit of \$200.00 per set. **Deposits will be refunded upon the return of said documents in good condition within 10 days after bids on the project have been opened.**
Note: Postal delays could affect delivery. Allow enough time for delivery and response.

A non-mandatory site walk is scheduled for Wednesday, January 25, 2006 @ 9:00 a.m., at the Mesa View Middle School, Calimesa, CA (Call Cal K-12 Construction, (909) 795-9169 for directions).

Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid bond, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the base bid amount, list of Designated Subcontractors, Certificate of Workers' Compensation, and notarized Non-Collusion Affidavit required by the Information For Bidders.

Labor Compliance Notice: Bidders are advised that this Contract is a public work for purposes of the California Labor Code, which requires payment of prevailing wages.

The District has adopted an approved Labor Compliance Program operated by Harris & Associates, a Certified Third-Party Labor Compliance services provider. Under this program Harris & Associates, representing the District, in part, will review and audit payroll records to verify compliance with labor laws and shall have the right to recommend payment withholdings and enforce penalties for non-compliance.

The District has obtained from the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations the general prevailing wage rates, and will place them on file at the Construction Manager's Office, located at: 32598 Oak Glen Road, Yucaipa, CA 92399, and make them available to any interested party upon request. Please call: (909) 795-9169 in advance to make arrangements.

Pursuant to Labor Code section 1771.7, the District has implemented and shall enforce a Labor Compliance Program ("LCP"). The successful contractor shall be required to comply with all the requirements of the Superintendent of Schools' LCP and applicable

provisions of the California Labor Code. In bidding on this Project, it shall be the bidder's responsibility to evaluate the cost of complying with the Superintendent of Schools' LCP. The bidders shall include in the contract amount all costs of compliance with specified requirements. The successful Contractor shall be responsible for complying with the provisions of the Superintendent of Schools' LCP, including the standard provisions requiring payment of prevailing wages, maintenance and submission of weekly certified payroll records, and hiring of apprenticeships as appropriate. The successful Contractor shall be required to attend, and invite subcontractors to attend, a pre-construction meeting at which a representative of Harris & Associates shall discuss labor law requirements. The successful Contractor shall work with the Superintendent of Schools and Pacific Program Management's staff to ensure the full compliance with the District's LCP and applicable labor law.

State Law and regulations adopted by the State Allocation Board require that state funded contracts have participation goals of three percent (3%) for Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises (DVBE), as defined in Public Contract Code Section 10115.1. To be considered, a contractor is required to meet the goals or to make a good faith effort to meet the DVBE participation goals as specified in the regulations. In awarding the contract, the District will consider the bidder's compliance with State Allocation Board (SAB) statutes and regulations related to DVBE. To be given any consideration a contractor must meet and document that it has met the goals or made a good faith effort to do so at the time their bid is submitted to the District by attaching the properly completed DVBE forms to their bid. The contractor must certify, under penalty of perjury, that all representations made regarding DVBE are true.

A Payment Bond and Performance Bond will be required of all contractors prior to the execution of the contract for all trades. The Payment Bond and Performance Bond shall be in the form and amount set forth in the Contract Documents. In addition, a Performance Bond will be required of all subcontractors providing goods and services that exceed \$50,000.00. These bonds shall be in the form and amount set forth in the Contract Documents.

In accordance with provisions of Public Contract Code Section 22300, substitution of eligible and equivalent securities for any monies withheld to ensure performance under this contract will be permitted at the request and expense of any contractor.

Each bidder shall possess at the time of bid a current contractor's license, pursuant to Public Contract Code section 3300 and Business and Professions Code Section 7028-15, for the applicable work proposed to be furnished. The successful bidder must maintain the license throughout the duration of this contract. Bidders responding to Bid Package #1 must possess a California Contractor's B license. Bidders responding to Bid Package #2 must possess a California Contractor's C-36 license. Bidders responding to Bid Package #3 must possess a California Contractor's C-20 license. Bidders responding to Bid Package #4 must possess a California Contractor's C-10 license. Bidders responding to Bid Package #5 must possess a California Contractor's C-6 license. Bidders responding to Bid Package #6 must possess a California Contractor's C-39 and C-43 license. Bidders responding to Bid Package #7 must possess a California Contractor's C-35 and C-9 license. Bidders responding to Bid Package #8 must possess a California Contractor's C-16 license.

No Bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 30 days after the date set for the opening thereof.

The District reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive irregularities in any bid.
