A pre-bid conference and walk-through will be held in front of Victor Valley Junior High School, 16925 Forrest Ave., Victorville, CA 92392 at 2 pm on Wednesday, October 26, 2005.

Bids must be received at the District Office Purchasing Department, 16350 Mojave Drive, Victorville, CA 92395 and will be opened and publicly read aloud at the above stated time in the District Board Room. All bids must be made on the bid form furnished by the District. BIDS MUST BE SUBMITTED AND RECEIVED AT THE DISTRICT OFFICE BEFORE THE TIME STATED. POST OFFICE STAMP WILL NOT SUFFICE.

It is the intent of the District to meet the goals as established by the State Allocation Board of the Department of General Services of the State of California with reference to Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise contracting goals. Therefore, each bidder must complete all the requirements outlined within the bid documents pertaining to the Disabled Veterans Business Enterprise contracting goals.

This project is a "public work" as defined within California Labor Code Section 1720. The District has initiated and enforces a Labor Compliance Program, ("LCP") that received "Initial Approval" from the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations ("DIR") in accordance with California Labor Code ("Labor Code") 1770, *et seq.* on March 24, 2003, which requires the payment of the general rate of per diem wages or the general rate of per diem for holiday and overtime work and the employment of apprentices for any State Funded School Facilities project of \$1,000 or more. A copy of the District's Labor Compliance Program and applicable DIR Wage Determinations are on file at the District Offices and are available for inspection or reference during normal business hours. Pursuant to the provisions of Public Contract Code Section 22300, Contractor may substitute certain securities for funds withheld by District to ensure his performance under the contract. At the request and expense of Contractor, securities equivalent to any amount withheld shall be deposited at the discretion of District, with either District or a state or federally chartered bank, as the escrow agent, who shall then pay any funds otherwise subject to retention to Contractor. Upon satisfactory completion of the contract, the securities shall be returned to Contractor. Each bid must conform and be responsive to all pertinent Bidding and Contract Documents. Prospective bidders may secure up to four (4) sets of the Contract Documents, plans and specifications documents, from the office of the Construction Manager – Cal K-12 Construction Management, 32598 Oak Glen Road, Yucaipa, Ca. 92399, Phone: (909) 795-9169, Fax: (909) 795-9432. The Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids or waive any irregularities or informalities in any bid or in the bidding, and to be the sole judge of the value and merit of the merchandise offered.
